What is CPE Monitor?

ACPE and the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy (NABP) developed a continuing pharmacy education (CPE) tracking service, CPE Monitor, which will authenticate and store data for completed CPE units received by pharmacists and pharmacy technicians from ACPE-accredited providers. This NABP program creates a central repository for all pharmacy CPE units and will be available to both state boards of pharmacy as well as pharmacists and pharmacy technicians for review and verifications of CPE.

All CE will be reported to the CPE monitor.
